Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct (appeyer identification number (TIM) to report, for example, income paid to you, payments made to you in settlement of payment and end third party network transactions, real estate transactions, mortgage exterest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TiN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:
